Notice is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, in exercise of its enabling powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made the above-named order the effect of which will be:

That no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along the following lengths of road:

- **U70006** from its junction with B4224 for a distance of 94m in a north-easterly direction
- **B4224** from a point 160m northwest of its junction with B4225 to a point 187m south of its junction with A449
- B4225 from its junction with B4224 to its junction with A449
- **A449** from a point 380m southwest of its junction with B4225 to a point 160m east of its junction with B4224

This Order shall come into operation on Friday 8 July 2022.

The County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the 1984 Act) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the 2004 Act) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the above-named Order.

- 1. The Herefordshire Council (Speed Limit) (Consolidation) Order 2022 ("the 2022 Order") shall be varied by the insertion of the new sealed plans specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 2. The effect of this Order is to introduce the restrictions set out in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 3. The remainder of the 2022 Order shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. This Order shall come into effect on the 8th day of July 2022 and may be cited as the "HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (SPEED LIMIT) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2022 (VARIATION) ORDER No.1 2022".

# (B4224, U70006, B4225 AND A449, OLD GORE) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT)

The implementation of the proposed speed limit under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 is necessary for the following reasons:

For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising

For preserving and improving the amenity of the area through which the road runs
