With this in mind it is vital that repair café become financially self-sustaining. Please detail your plans for doing this. Think about accepting donations for repairs, tea & coffee sales, sponsorships and further funding opportunities.

If you are applying to be a new Repair Café please your baseline figures are likely to be nil, however if you are an existing repair café please input your current number of visitors.

To complete this section you can consider the catchment area of your venue, advertising reach, number of volunteers, and what has been achieved at other repair café.

Please remember we are happy for you to start small and grow.
