The County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council in exercise of its powers under Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the 1984 Act) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the 2004 Act) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, proposes to make the above-named Order the effect of which will be that:

The existing 10 tonne structural weight limit on C1001 at Buckton and the existing 5 tonne structural weight limit on C1011 at Kinsham are proposed to be revoked in full. The bridges have recently been strengthened. Therefore, the weight restrictions are no longer required. Unsuitable for HGV Signage will be implemented to deal with traffic taking unsuitable routes, despite the strengthening of the bridges.




