NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO CORRECT A MISTAKE MADE BY THE COMMONS REGISTRATION AUTHORITY IN MAKING AN ENTRY IN THE REGISTER OF COMMON LAND

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below, and to all others whom it may concern.

A proposal has been made by the Commons Registration Authority, Herefordshire Council, Plough Lane, Hereford HR4 0LE under Section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2008. The proposal seeks to correct a mistake in the Register which was made by the Registration Authority. The mistake to be corrected is to the plan only of CL57 Bircher Common in that the Registration Authority included, on the original plan, part of the Common which should have been omitted, as shown on the plan below. The description of the Common in writing is correct.

The proposal, which includes a plan of the land that it is proposed to exclude, may be inspected at the following offices: Commons Registration Office, Herefordshire Council, Plough Lane, Hereford HR4 0LE, by appointment between the hours of 9am and 4pm, Monday to Friday. Any person wishing to object to this proposal should send a written signed statement of the facts upon which the objection is based to the Commons Registration Officer, Herefordshire Council, PO Box 4, Plough Lane, Hereford HR4 0XH or via email to commonsregistration@herefordshire.gov.uk to arrive no later than midday Monday 20th June 2011.

In accordance with paragraph 26(2) of The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2008, representations:

- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the proposal or proposal;
- may include an email address of the person making them;
- must be signed by the person making them, and
- must state the grounds on which they are made.

Any representations that are to be taken into account in reaching a decision on the proposal cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties, and dealt with in accordance with the Regulations.

Where applicable and in accordance with paragraph 27(3)(c) of the 2008 Regulations, the proposal, together with any representations, will be referred to the Planning Inspectorate (PINS) for determination. Additionally, in accordance with paragraph 37(1) of the 2008 Regulations, if the proposal is granted, in whole or in part, the Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by registering the land in the Register of Common Land.






