



## THE COMMONS ACT 2006: SCHEDULE 2 PARAGRAPH 6

## NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO DEREGISTER A BUILDING WRONGLY REGISTERED AS COMMON LAND

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below, and to all others whom it may concern.

An application has been made by Mr A.C.R. Watkins and Mrs J.C. Watkins of Silver Birch Cottage, Yatton Hill, Aymestrey, Near Leominster HR6 9TN under Schedule 2 paragraph 6 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2008. The application seeks to deregister a building wrongly registered as common land, and described in the Schedule below.

The application, which includes a plan of the land that it is proposed to exclude, may be inspected at the following offices: Commons Registration Office, Herefordshire Council, Franklin House, 4 Commercial Road, Hereford, HR1 2BB, by appointment between the hours of 9am and 5pm, Monday to Friday. Any person wishing to object to this application should send a written signed statement of the facts upon which the objection is based to the Commons Registration Officer, Herefordshire Council, Franklin House, 4 Commercial Road, Hereford HR1 2BB or via email to <a href="mailto:commonsregistration@herefordshire.gov.uk">commonsregistration@herefordshire.gov.uk</a> to arrive no later than midday Friday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2011.

In accordance with paragraph 26(2) of The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2008, representations:

- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application or proposal;
- · may include an email address of the person making them;
- must be signed by the person making them, and
- must state the grounds on which they are made.

Any representations that are to be taken into account in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties, and dealt with in accordance with the Regulations.

Where applicable and in accordance with paragraph 27(3)(c) of the 2008 Regulations, the application, together with any representations, will be referred to the Planning Inspectorate (PINS) for determination. Additionally, in accordance with paragraph 37(1) of the 2008 Regulations, if the application is granted, in whole or in part, the Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by registering the land in the Register of Common Land.
