# **Breinton Loop**

## Key

Directions have been abbreviated as follows: R = Right L = Left SO = Straight on/over

# **Heading out**

- 1 From the Cycle Cabin (**Point A**) turn into Wye St then R toward the lights at the Old Bridge. Before the bridge turn L onto the riverside path (shared use).
- 2 Continue under Hunderton Bridge. Turn sharp L through barriers and up the ramp
- 3 Bear sharp L onto the Great Western Way (GWW) to cross over the river.
- 4 Before the GWW passes under Barton Rd bridge turn L up ramp onto Broomy Hill
- 5 L onto Broomy Hill out of the City; SO for approx 2½ miles to a T junction (**Point B**).

At **Point B** there is a choice of two shortuts:

#### **Shortcut 1** (approx 4 miles in total)

- 6 R into Breinton Rd, back towards the City
- 7 Join road and shortcut at Y junction in approx ½ mile (**Point C**)

#### **Shortcut 2** (approx 5 miles in total)

- 6 Cross Breinton Rd and continue along lane
- 7 At T-junction (approx. ¼ mile) R towards the City
- 8 Join road and other routes at Y junction in approx ½ mile (**Point C**)

#### **To ride the full Breinton Loop** (approx 6 miles in total)

- 6 L and SO along Breinton Rd away from the City, passing Breinton Church on the left
- 7 Pass Breinton Village. At T junction (approx 1 mile) R over Adam Hill

### **Heading back**

8 Join road and shortcut at Y junction (**Point C**)

#### All routes come together at Y junction (Point C)

- 9 SO into built-up area
- 10 Take care and R into Tower Rd, immediately before Give Way junction with Westfaling St
- 11 From Tower Rd L into Prince Edward Rd
- 12 At the end of Prince Edward Rd turn L into Broomy Hill
- 13 Just before the end of Broomy Hill (approx. 200yds) R down ramp onto the GWW
- 14 R and retrace route back to the Cycle Cabin (directions 4–1)
