

Easy rides

in and around Hereford

Haywood Country Park and Grafton Loop (page 1)

Key

Directions have been abbreviated as follows:
R = Right L = Left SO = Straight on/over

Heading South

- From the Cycle Cabin (**Point A**), turn into Wye St, then R toward the lights at the Old Bridge. Before the bridge turn L onto the riverside path (shared use)
 - Continue under Hunderton Bridge. Turn sharp L through barriers and up the ramp
 - Bear R onto Great Western Way (GWW). SO for approx. 1.5 miles over bridge over Belmont Rd
 - Pass open space / skateboard park on the right and the Academy school on the left
- At **Point B** you can take a shortcut, avoiding Haywood Country Park and Grafton village

Shortcut available (some light traffic)

- At T junction L towards the Academy
- SO along shared-use path through barriers
- At the end of the path join Marlbrook Rd
- SO along Marlbrook Rd to ramp on R, leading down to toucan crossing over A49 Ross Road (**Point D**)

- At the T junction R and immediately L through the low wooden barriers onto Shaw's path
- At **Point C** there is a choice of two routes:

To visit Haywood Country Park

- At the triangle of paths by the playing fields, veer R
- At the far end of playing fields R through the car park SO through to exit on to Vernon Williams Close

- Turn L into Treago Grove
- Treago Grove becomes Waterfield Rd, L into car park – continue SO onto shared-use path into the park

To return, re-trace the route back to Point C

Haywood Country Park and Grafton Loop

- Both routes 5 miles
- Traffic-free paths and quiet roads
- Loop includes short stretch on A49 Ross Rd
