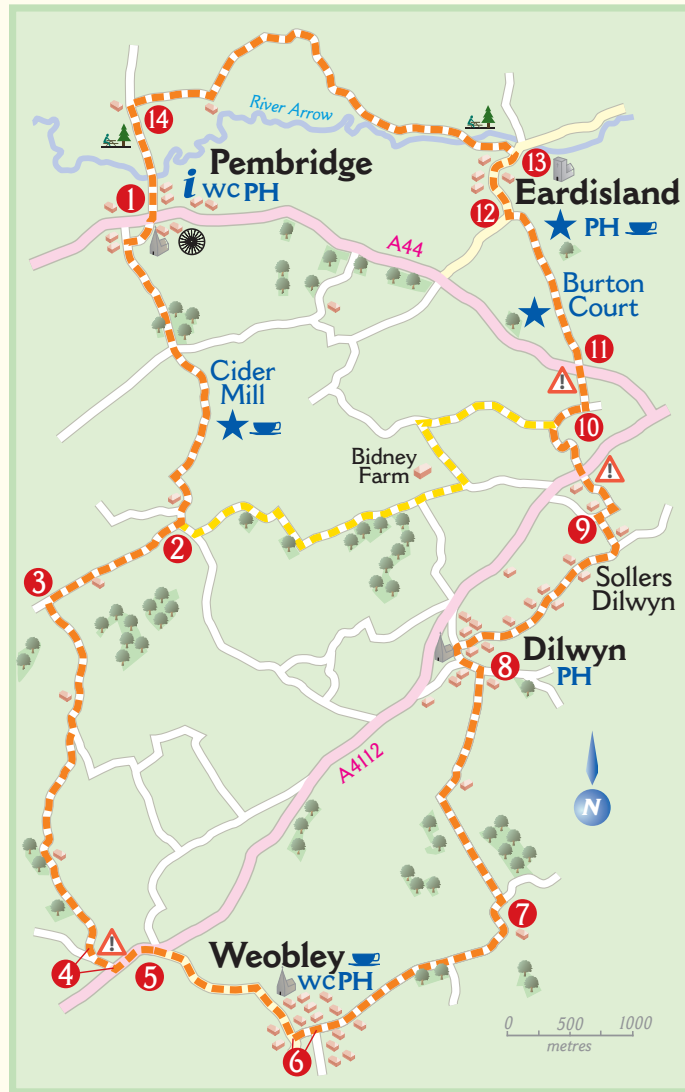

Enjoy delightful historic villages, gentle hills and secluded valleys as you cycle from Pembridge to Weoley, Dilwyn and Eardisland, passing Dunkertons Cider Mill and Burton Court. All the churches are worth visiting. Weoley church does teas in the summer. The short route is ideal for families, as it avoids the short stretch of the A4112.

Cycling with care

It is safest to follow the route anti-clockwise. The lanes are shared with other vehicles - please take care. Wear brightly coloured clothing and use lights after dark so that you can be seen. Follow the Highway Code at all times. Cycle helmets are recommended, especially for children.

Directions

- 1 Leave Pembridge up lane by The New Inn (SP Village Hall/Bearwood)

For the short route

- 2 L (SP Bereton) after Luntley dovecot
1st L after Bidney Farm
R at T and continue from 11

For the long route

- 2 R after Luntley dovecot (unclear SP)
- 3 1st L
- 4 SO at 'Y' to main road then L onto A4112 **take care** (SP Leominster/Dilwyn/Weoley)
- 5 R (SP Weoley)
- 6 SO for public WC and café
L opposite The Old Forge, passing the Salutation and the Unicorn Inn
L (SO) (SP Weoley Marsh/Dilwyn)
- 7 1st L opposite 'Little Stocking'
- 8 L at T (SP Dilwyn/Leominster) then R in Dilwyn and 1st R opposite church
- 9 1st L ('unsuitable for heavy goods vehicles') then R at T
- 10 SO A4112 **take care**
Take care on poor road surface then R at T
- 11 SO A44 (SP Burton Court) **take care crossing the A44**
- 12 R at T (SP Eardisland)
- 13 L before bridge (SP Old Ford picnic site)
- 14 L at T and continue to Pembridge (picnic site and safe paddling spot before bridge on R)
