

FOOTPATH CLOSED PUBLIC NOTICE OF MAKING

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)

**HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL
PUBLIC FOOTPATH MD9A, MUCH DEWCHURCH,
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2024**

NOTICE is hereby given that Herefordshire Council has made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) the effect of which is to temporarily close part of the following public footpath:

Public Footpath MD9A at OS Grid Reference SO 4973 3175.

The Order for closure is required due to a fallen tree.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit pedestrian access (and/or vehicular access at the discretion of the statutory undertaker) to any land or premises having a frontage to the above said highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to any access allowing the necessary works to be undertaken.

There is no alternative route.

The Order comes into force on 29 January 2024 for a period not exceeding six months from the said above date of operation (unless extended upon the direction of the Secretary of State) or until any said works which it is proposed to be carried out have been completed, (whichever is the earlier), or until determined by the Herefordshire Council.
