# HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

## HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL FOOTPATH CW3 (PART) COLWALL PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024

This Order is made by the County of Herefordshire District Council (known as "Herefordshire Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to Herefordshire Council that in the interests of the owner, lessee and occupier of the land crossed by the footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Louise Hawes, the said owner, has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and to pay any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

### BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situated at Hope Court in the parish of Colwall and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2. There shall be on the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situated at Hope Court in the parish of Colwall described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the said plan.
- 3. Where immediately before the date on which the said footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of their undertakings, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
- 4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

# PART 1

## Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

The existing route of footpath CW3 commences at a pedestrian gate at OS Grid Reference SO 7535 4371 (point A on the order plan) and follows a generally east-south-easterly direction for approximately 73 metres to the County road C1162 at OS Grid Reference SO 7542 4369 (point B on the order plan).

The total length of the existing said footpath is approximately 73 metres.

# PART 2

#### Description of Site of New Path or Way

The proposed new route of footpath CW3 being 2 metres in width commences at a pedestrian gate at OS Grid Reference SO 7535 4371 (point A on the order plan) and follows a southerly direction for 6 metres to a pedestrian gate at OS Grid Reference SO 7535 4371 (point C on the order plan). It continues in a generally east-south-easterly direction for approximately 66 metres to a pedestrian gate at OS Grid reference SO 7541 4368 (point D on the order plan), then in an easterly direction for approximately 7 metres to the County road C1162 at OS Grid Reference SO 7542 4368 (point E on the order plan).

The total length of the said proposed new footpath is approximately 79 metres.
