PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL FOOTPATH ZC22 (PART) LEOMINSTER PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025

This Order is made by the County of Herefordshire District Council (known as "Herefordshire Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to Herefordshire Council that in the interests of the owner, lessee and occupier of the land crossed by the footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

WM Morrison Supermarkets Limited, the said owner, has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and to pay any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situated at Morrisons Supermarket in the town of Leominster and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date that Herefordshire Council certifies that works have been carried out to bring the site of the new footpath described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order into a fit condition for use by the public.
- 2. There shall be on the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situated at Morrisons Supermarket in the town of Leominster described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the said plan.
- 3. Where immediately before the date on which the said footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of their undertakings, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
- 4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

The existing route of footpath ZC22 commences at OS Grid Reference SO 4838 5854 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in a north north-westerly direction across the supermarket car park for approximately 165 metres and rises up a steep bank to County road A44 at OS Grid Reference SO 4832 5869 (point B on the order plan).

The total length of the existing said footpath is approximately 165 metres.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way

The proposed new route of footpath ZC22 being 2 metres in width commences at OS Grid Reference SO 4838 5854 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in a north easterly direction along the verge for approximately 14 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 4839 5854 (point C on the order plan). It then turns in a generally north north-westerly direction around the frontage of the supermarket for approximately 133 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 4835 5866 (point D on the order plan) and continues in a north north-westerly direction across a pedestrian crossing point for approximately 37 metres and rises up a set of steps to County road A44 at OS Grid Reference SO 4833 5870 (point E on the order plan).

The total length of the said proposed new footpath is approximately 184 metres.
