

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

**HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL
FOOTPATH WQ1 (PART) WIGMORE
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

This Order is made by the County of Herefordshire District Council (known as "Herefordshire Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to Herefordshire Council that in the interests of the owner, lessee and occupier of the land crossed by the footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Andrew Lunnon and Sarah Lunnon, the said owners, have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and to pay any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Castle Inn Caravan Park in the parish of Wigmore and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall be on the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situated at Castle Inn Caravan Park in the parish of Wigmore described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the said plan.
3. Where immediately before the date on which the said footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of their undertakings, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

The existing route of footpath WQ1 commences at OS Grid Reference SO 4152 6906 and continues in a generally north north-easterly direction for approximately 146 metres to a footbridge OS Grid Reference SO 4156 6920 (point B on the order plan).

The total length of the existing said footpath is approximately 146 metres.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way

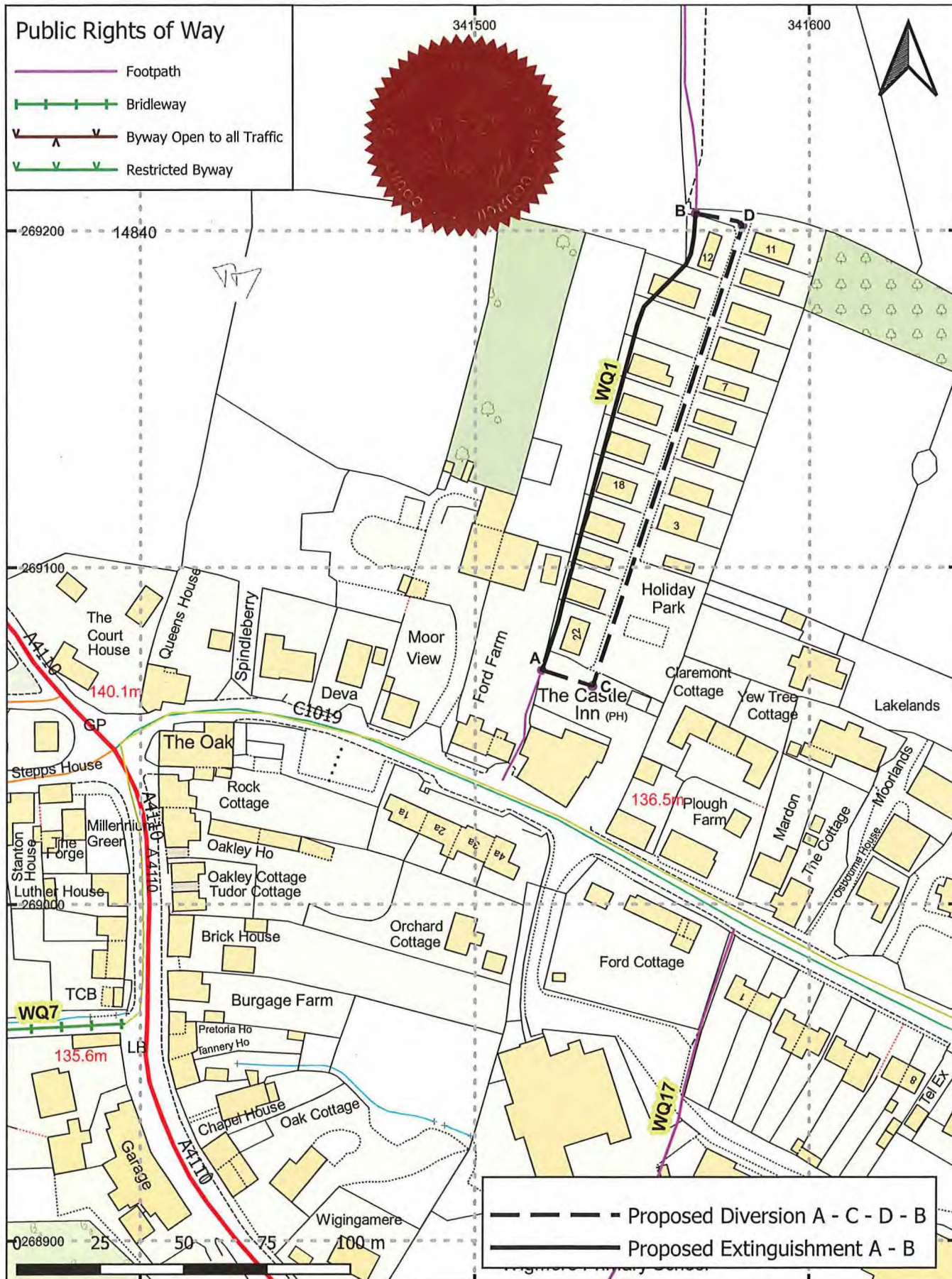
The proposed new route of footpath WQ1 being 2 metres in width commences at a pedestrian gate at OS Grid Reference SO 4152 6906 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in an east south-easterly direction across a car park for approximately 16 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 4153 6906 (point C on the order plan). It continues in a generally north north-easterly direction for approximately 144 metres along the caravan park access track to OS Grid Reference SO 4157 6920 (point D on the order plan) before turning in a west north-westerly direction for approximately 15 metres to a footbridge as OS Grid Reference SO 4156 6920 (point B on the order plan).

The total length of the said proposed new footpath is approximately 175 metres.
