HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL PUBLIC FOOTPATH BPF34 (PART) BISHOPS FROME PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025

The above order made on 22nd July, 2025 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert that length of Footpath BPF34 (Part) in the Parish of Bishops Frome which commences at OS Grid Reference SO 6732 5070 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 170 metres to a gap at OS Grid Reference SO 6747 5078 (point B on the order plan). The path continues in a generally east north-easterly direction for approximately 101 metres then in a generally easterly direction for approximately 141 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 6769 5084 (point C on the order plan). The total length of the existing said footpath is approximately 412 metres.

An alternative footpath will be created, being 2 metres in width, which commences at OS Grid Reference SO 6732 5070 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in a generally easterly direction for approximately 152 metres to a gap at OS Grid reference SO 6747 5072 (point D on the order plan). The path continues in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 251 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 6769 5084 (point C on the order plan). The total length of this public footpath will be approximately 403 metres.
