




The implementation of the proposed Prohibition of Motor Vehicles (Except for Access) under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of Part I and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the 2004 Act) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, is necessary for the following reasons:


- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- For preserving or improving the amenity of the area through which the road runs.
- To prevent motor vehicles that do not have a requirement to access Pilley Road or Clifton Road from entering the road. This would prevent drivers who are utilising Pilley Road and Clifton Road as a through route from doing so, but enable residents, their visitors and deliveries to continue to utilise the road as usual.
- To prevent accelerated damage to the highway.




