

BYWAYS AND BRIDLEWAYS LOCAL MONITORING GROUPAPPLICATION FOR A MODIFICATION ORDERWILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT

TO: The Chief Executive of Hereford and Worcester County Council

I, Geoffrey Brookes of Churchyard Cottage, Church Lane, Orleton, Near Ludlow, Shropshire SY8 4HU hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding the byway open to all traffic from GR376669 (Point 'A') at the southern end of the publicly maintainable highway numbered 92014 on the County Surveyor's map, in a southerly direction to meet the northern end of the publicly maintainable highway numbered 92013 (Point 'B') at Limebrook in the parish of Lingen at GR 374662.

The route was shown on the list of publicly maintainable highways kept by the County Surveyor where it was identified as a through way numbered 275. It has been omitted from the current list and 'whited-out' on the accompanying map though no extinguishing order was made. All publicly maintainable highways shown on this list have admitted vehicular rights over them.
