

Herefordshire targeted short breaks allowance scheme

The targeted allowance is intended to enable the main carers to have a break from caring and to support their child to access leisure activities. It may be used in a number of different ways and popular activities have included swimming, visiting the cinema and attending various groups and clubs. In addition, Herefordshire council has a menu of activities, detailed below, which may be suitable for your child to access.

Menu of activities

- Families, in receipt of an approved allowance, can choose from the menu of activities and book places directly with the provider.
- Approved allowances are paid directly into the family's nominated bank account.
- Each activity provider will explain their payment terms, e.g. payment before or after the activity.
- Activities will be funded by the allowance and a contribution paid by the child's family, as follows:
