

Rural Areas Site Allocation Development Plan Document (RASA DPD) Questionnaire

The RASA DPD is seeking to provide a policy framework and growth proposals to support the delivery of the Herefordshire Core Strategy for those market towns or parishes which are not included within a neighbourhood development plan.

The Issues and Options Paper of the RASA DPD presents a number of potential options for the scope of the document; which parishes should be included within the plan. It also presents options regarding the range of policy topics which could be included, such as settlement boundaries, housing and employment allocations and primary shopping areas.
